Important Reminder for Collection Location Pharmacies

1 Who is HPSA?

HPSA is a not-for-profit association funded by the health products industry. It operates collection and disposal programs of unused/unwanted medications generated by the public

2 What is Accepted?

- Prescription drugs
- Over-the-counter medications
- Natural health products



Note: Liquid and cream medications should be in their primary packaging. Only 10 inhalers per container.
In British Columbia and Ontario unused or expired medications for companion animals are also accepted

3 What is Not Accepted?

Empty pill bottles or any outer packaging, cosmetics or beauty products



4 How to Order a Service?

Once the containers are full, go to HPSA webpage www.healthsteward.ca and locate Service and Supply Request Form under Pharmacists tab



5 How to Submit a Service Request Form?

Insert your HPSA ID and fill out all the required information. Submit the form online on the webpage
