Message from the CEO

Dear Stakeholders,

I'm pleased to report 2024 was a year of significant achievement for the Health Products Stewardship Association (HPSA).

It was a year marked by substantial progress in fostering consumer engagement in take-back programs, strengthening collaboration with collection partners, and continuing efforts to educate consumers about the environmental impact of incorrect disposal of health products while promoting sustainable stewardship practices. Our take-back programs are carefully designed to ensure the safe, compliant, and environmentally responsible disposal of unused or expired medications.

HPSA experienced significant growth in member recruitment in 2024, reaching a total of 150 members. This growth highlights the increased commitment of health products producers to fulfill their Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) obligations. Through our collective stewardship programs, HPSA helps its members meet these obligations by ensuring the safe disposal of products at the end of their life cycle, supporting a more sustainable and responsible approach to health product management.

We are committed to working with the province to ensure compliance and environmental stewardship in accordance with British Columbia Recycling Regulation under the province's Environmental Management Act (B.C. Reg. 449/2004).

On behalf of our members, HPSA administers the British Columbia Medications Return Program (BCMRP) for pharmaceutical products (prescription drugs, non-prescription drugs, and natural health products) that are sold for use in the "consumer/residential" waste stream.

In 2024, HPSA grew the collection network to **1,047 locations** across British Columbia, representing an **68.5%** participation rate of all licensed pharmacies in the province. HPSA collected **98,786 kilograms** of unwanted medications. These achievements were possible due the collaborative efforts of our collection locations.

As the organization enters its 25th year of existence, HPSA remains devoted to continuous improvements in the delivery of the BCMRP. As we continue to execute our strategy and work towards achieving our goals, we look forward to enhancing consumer participation, improving accessibility, and promoting safe disposal of health products.

Collection System

Section 5 (1) (c) (iii) of the regulation requires that a plan must adequately provide for reasonable and free consumer access to collection facilities.

HPSA's BCMRP has an established and comprehensive network of permanent collection facilities at community pharmacies, providing the public with convenient locations to return pharmaceuticals. In 2024, 1,047 retail pharmacies in British Columbia were registered with HPSA, representing 68.5% of all retail pharmacies in the province.

A summary table that shows the number of registered collection facilities sites per capita by regional district can be found in [Section VI](#).

HPSA conducts an accessibility study every two years. The most recent study reported a provincial accessibility rate of 98.5%, as detailed in the 2023 Annual Report. The results of the next accessibility study will be included in the 2025 Annual Report.

Section II: Program Outline

The Health Products Stewardship Association (HPSA) is a not-for-profit industry stewardship organization that meets its obligations as outlined in the BC extra-provincial Society Act, and files the required reports with the Corporate Property Registry Branch of the Ministry of Finance. HPSA has been registered with Industry Canada since 2000.

HPSA has an approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan to meet pharmaceutical producers' regulatory obligations as established by BC Recycling Regulation 449/2004. As of December 2024, HPSA membership includes 150 stewards who have appointed the organization as their Producer Responsibility Organization in BC ([Appendix 1](#)).

The British Columbia Medications Return Program (BCMRP) is designed to manage unused and/or expired Pharmaceuticals from the residential sector.

Accepted Pharmaceutical Products

1. Prescription drugs
2. Non-prescription drugs
3. Natural Health Products

The Program accepts products that are attributable to existing stewards orphan and free rider products. Orphan products are pharmaceuticals that are no longer in production, or the producer is no longer in business, or were purchased outside of Canada. Free rider products refer to items that are designated under the regulation but are produced, imported, or distributed by a producer that is not a registered member of HPSA in British Columbia.

HPSA provides collection containers and collateral materials at no charge to collection facilities and pays for the shipping and disposal costs. Participation in the Program is free for collection facilities and to the public. The BC collection system has been designed with user convenience and flexibility in mind.

Collection facilities for the BCMRP are community pharmacies. Pharmacy managers who wish to participate must complete and sign a "Collection Location Agreement". Program details are provided to ensure that managers and staff are fully informed about the Program and its operations. All participating pharmacies receive a guide containing instructions for public communication as well as procedures for handling medication containers.

Section III: Public Education Materials and Strategies

1. Provincial and National Campaigns

In 2024, HPSA developed and executed a range of nationwide and regional initiatives to boost program awareness, education and engagement. This section highlights key campaigns from the year. Through earned outreach efforts, these campaigns secured 6 interviews, 2 press releases, and 18.5 million impressions.

Recycling Council of British Columbia

HPSA supports the Recycling Council of British Columbia's (RCBC) Information Services — a province-wide resource that helps residents access reliable information about recycling, pollution prevention, and safe disposal options. This service assists British Columbians in properly disposing of unwanted products and helps them locate convenient collection sites throughout the province.

Don't Dump Drugs

HPSA's "Don't Dump Drugs" campaign aims to raise awareness about the environmental dangers of improper medication disposal. The campaign focuses on simple, engaging messaging that resonates across generations and cultures, using the memorable slogan "Don't Dump Drugs" to drive the message home.

By personifying common disposal methods, like toilets and trash bins, we emphasize the harmful consequences these actions have on the environment. In addition, a new logo, inspired by the recycling symbol, was created to promote safe disposal practices and encourage the return of medications to pharmacies. This initiative seeks to change behaviours and foster greater public participation in protecting the environment through responsible disposal.

The “Unflushable” Campaign

HPSA actively supported the "Unflushable" campaign led by Metro Vancouver. This initiative aimed to educate the public about the harmful impact of flushing medications, and other “unflushable” items down toilets or drains. By raising awareness, the campaign promoted responsible disposal practices to protect the environment and wastewater systems. To educate the public on how to return medications, HPSA provided printed materials —cards, magnet stickers, posters—to more than 1,200 registered collection pharmacies throughout the province.

National Drug Drop Off Month

In recognition of National Drug Drop-Off Month in August, HPSA collaborated with Drug Free Kids (DFK) Canada to raise awareness among Canadian parents and consumers about the correct way to dispose of unused medication and safe storage in the household. A 2023 Leger survey, commissioned by HPSA, revealed that 70% of Canadian parents admit to leaving their medications in a place that is accessible by their children and 87% of Canadian parents do not consider the safe disposal of unwanted medications as essential.

The campaign was divided into 4 components:

- 1) **Radio Campaign:** A joint Radio Campaign under the theme of “unfortunately, it happens too often” was aired for 13 weeks in 240 radio outlets across Canada, reaching a total broadcast of 23,000.
- 2) **Nation-wide Webinar:** Webinars explored the impact of substance use on youth mental health, particularly during the back-to-school season while focusing on limiting access to drugs by returning unwanted medications. HPSA’s CEO had an intervention segment during the webinars to help parents prevent misuse in their household.
- 3) **Activation Event:** HPSA participated in “Take-back day”, in collaboration with Rexall pharmacies, to promote safe disposal and engage the communities in the return program. The attendees were provided with educational material, learned more about the campaign and the role families and caregivers play in prevention efforts.
- 4) **Media News Highlights:** To promote this initiative, articles were published in 104 print and digital outlets. HPSA was interviewed on a CTV News report, and with our partner DFK, participated in a segment on The Evan Bray Show.

2. Partnerships for First Nations

HPSA participates in the First Nations Recycling Initiative (FNRI), a collaboration of producer responsibility organizations working to support recycling in First Nation communities across British Columbia. Through this initiative, HPSA and other partners engage directly with communities to share information about BC’s recycling stewardship programs and assist with local collection events and existing recycling efforts. FNRI aims to foster long-term partnerships and help ensure equitable access to recycling services throughout the province.

3. Conferences and Symposiums

In 2024, HPSA actively engaged with industry experts and educational institutions to enhance awareness of the BCMRP program. The organization participated in a range of conferences and symposiums aimed at informing the public, pharmacists and producers, with the goal of driving program awareness, members’ engagement and increasing participation at collection facilities. These efforts were part of a broader strategy to elevate program visibility and foster stronger industry collaboration.

Speaking Engagement: Canadian Health Food Association (CHFA)

At the 2024 CHFA conference, HPSA discussed Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for health product producers. HPSA highlighted the importance of EPR programs in promoting sustainability and ensuring that producers take responsibility for the lifecycle of their products. By participating in the conference, HPSA helped raise awareness among producers about their evolving obligations under EPR regulations and encouraged industry-wide collaboration to create more sustainable practices in the health products sector.

4. Social Media and Website:

In 2024, HPSA achieved significant growth and engagement through our social media channels, amplifying our reach and impact within the health products sector. Through a combination of organic content and targeted paid digital ads, we effectively expanded our audience base and increased awareness of key initiatives.

Insights:

- The paid ads allowed us to broaden our visibility and connect with new stakeholders with more than 300,000 impressions.
- The campaign generated more than 6,000 visits to the website.
- This balanced approach helped strengthen our online presence, resulting in increased interactions and a deeper connection with our audience.

HPSA's website underwent a comprehensive revamp, resulting in a more streamlined and user-friendly layout. The site now features distinct sections and detailed guidelines for each province, for Consumers and Collection Locations separately, offering updated information on the proper procedures for returning medical sharps and medications. New resources have also been added.

5. Educational Materials

HPSA enhanced its educational assets to ensure users can easily access vital resources and information. The updated guides now offer a more streamlined and informative layout, featuring direct links to educational videos, collection point maps, and other materials available on the HPSA website. These resources are designed to provide clear, step-by-step guidance on the safe disposal of medications, as well as other critical topics. The updates aim to improve consumer knowledge and foster greater participation in safe disposal practices.

Once again, HPSA partnered with Recycle BC to include information in their annual Recycling Guide, highlighting that empty medication packaging can be recycled through Recycle BC, while unused or expired medications should be returned to a community pharmacy.

Section IV: Collection System and Accessibility

Collection facilities for the BCMRP are retail community pharmacies with a public-facing dispensary. Pharmacies are a logical and safe system for the public to return unwanted medications. Many have extended hours, offering a convenient place for consumer disposal year-round. Every collection facility has an agreement with HPSA regarding the collection and storage of unused and expired products. Community pharmacies currently participating in the Program can be located by the public on HPSA's geolocator map available on its website at <https://healthsteward.ca/find-a-collection-location/>.

HPSA reports on program accessibility every second year. The results of the last accessibility study were included in the 2023 annual report and concluded that there is a 98.5 percent provincial accessibility rate (98.1% rural accessibility and 98.6% urban accessibility). The results of the next accessibility study will be disclosed in the 2025 annual report.

Section V: Pollution Prevention Hierarchy and Product Management

The pollution prevention hierarchy emphasizes managing materials at the highest possible level. However, in the case of pharmaceuticals, options such as reduction, reuse, and recycling are not appropriate, as they would pose unacceptable health risks to the public.

In 2024, HPSA disposed 100% of all qualifying program products collected in British Columbia through incineration at the Waste-to-Energy site in Burnaby, BC.

Section VI: Products Sold and Collected and Recovery Rate

The table below shows the number of registered collection facilities per capita by regional district and demonstrates the high level of consumer access and program coverage in British Columbia.

Medications may have a long delay between the time of purchase and return. Prescription drugs should be fully consumed unless otherwise directed by a health professional. The *Medications Return Program* collects medications, not the bottle or vial used to market the product or used to dispense the prescription. HPSA recommends that containers be recycled by the consumer through the provincial packaging and paper product program.

In 2024, the average weight of post-consumer pharmaceuticals returned per capita was 0.02 kg representing a total weight of 98,786 kg of pharmaceuticals returned for disposal. The highest weight

returned for a regional district was Metro Vancouver at 48,669.7 kg, followed by the Capital region at 12,738.9 kg.

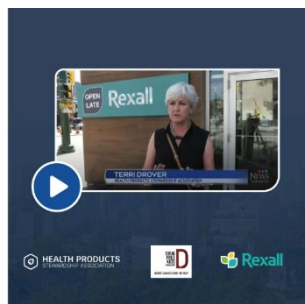


